Position Overview: The bartender will be customer service focused and dedicated to providing and maintaining a fun and safe atmosphere that the Starbottle Saloon is known for. The Starbottle bartender must be positive minded, hardworking, and enthusiastic, and have a passion for the outdoors. A basic understanding of ski area operations specific to Anthony Lakes is must for this position. This position's focus is consistent operations of the Starbottle Saloon, following all OLCC and Anthony Lakes Mountain Resort (ALMR) guidelines, all while ensuring that ALMR is a safe, family-friendly environment.

Main Functions:

- Ensures proper opening, closing, cleaning and ordering procedures are followed.
- Operate the Starbottle Saloon by serving drinks and food effectively and safely, following all OLCC & ALMR guidelines
- Work with other Starbottle staff under the supervision of the Director of Lodge Operations to ensure proper opening, closing, cleaning, and ordering procedures are followed.
- Assist the Director of Lodge Operations in the oversight of all lodge operations, lodge cleaning and maintenance, and other activities & events at ALMR.

Duties:

- Serve food & beverage in a friendly, efficient, and safe manner
- Prep bar opening prior to bar opening to the public
- Responsible for end of shift paperwork
- Maintain bar Incident log for every shift
- Responsible for downstairs maintenance, cleaning and trouble shooting
- Provide stellar customer service (quick, efficient, friendly)
- Have a solid knowledge of Anthony Lakes Mountain Resort (ALMR) endeavors to give correct information to guests
- Maintain a clean customer and personal work environment.
- Ensure a safe and efficient workplace, while also ensuring guest safety through identifying and mitigating any potential hazards.

Qualifications:

- Possess a valid OLCC permit
- Ability to assess situations and make responsible decisions as issues arise quickly and accurately
- Strong customer service skills
- Strong organization and prioritization skills with ability to thrive under pressure
- Excellent verbal communication skills a must
- Basic computer skills with email, MS Word and the ability to write creatively

Other Qualifications:

- Must possess a driver's license and have an acceptable driving record to meet all insurance requirements
- Must be able to lift and carry 50lbs repeatedly
